## Diary dates

- The AGM will be held on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> March. It is vital that as many members as possible attend as there will be some important decisions to take about the Club's future.
- We have fixed the dates for three Quiz Nights: 14<sup>th</sup> January; 5<sup>th</sup> May and 6<sup>th</sup> October. These are always popular so watch out for posters with more details and get your tickets early!

## News Update

- 6<sup>th</sup> Squash Court: we have spent a lot of time working with our neighbour and have at last secured a fifty year rent-free lease for the extra land we need. This allows us to proceed with a planning application to WDC and there will shortly be notices going up at the Club's entrance. We have held discussions with England Squash who have again confirmed they intend to make a financial award to the Club. If we are successful with our planning application we expect to be able to build a business case and present it to you.
- Croquet: it appears we have been somewhat remiss in erecting the wooden pavilions around the croquet lawns without consent from WDC. We will be correcting this and there will be more planning notices being displayed.
- Local Fire Officer's visit: we recently had a surprise visit and are now required to make some improvements to the heater enclosures and the layout of the squash corridor. Whilst doing this work we plan to install a glass back on court 5 and change the layout of the viewing area using funds raised by the Squash Section.
- Tennis Floodlights: we have serviced the floodlights which has made a dazzling improvement to the light levels!

The Club continues to have a healthy balance sheet and we are poised to make some significant investments in 2012. However, I have been President for over five years and it's time for me to stand down. Mike Storey, our General Secretary, is also not standing again for election at the AGM. The Club will not run itself and it needs your input to help these investment projects succeed. There are projects to run and various positions on the General Committee to fill for 2012. Please consider taking one of these key roles to help your Club to the next stage of its future.
